THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION'S BIODIVERSITY STRATEGY

calls for **€20 billion** per year to save nature.



WE NEED MONEY FOR NATURE NOW



REFORM THE CAP

we should **invest 1/4** of it, **€15 billion** per year, in nature-friendly farming.



THE CAP, THE COMMON AGRICULTURAL POLICY,

Over 1/3 of the EU's budget, is worth **€60 billion** per year and supports intensive agriculture.

MONEY FOR NATURE MEANS SUPPORTING FARMERS.

WE NEED THAT MONEY TO...



...manage and **restore** natural habitats and landscape **features**.



...carry out **conservation** work for **threatened** species.

...monitor and advise on **biodiversity** measures.

80% of the payments (**€36 billion** per year) goes to the top **20%**.



One third of direct payments to farmers (**€13 billion** per year) goes to the top **1.5%**



The **bigger** the farm you own, the more **money** you get.
